

ODR Handbook Editor's Annual Report

The following revisions were made to the ODR Handbook in 2019-2020 season:

- Updated Board of Directors and Administrative Staff page to include new Directors, terms of office, and additions/changes to staff
- Added "Good Standing" definitions to Membership section
- Added language regarding impact of non-certified coaching staff on COIs
- Added registration category for Event Worker, registration fee (\$15), and background screen fee (\$30)
- Updated registration fees for outdoor and summer memberships (\$21.25)
- Updated background screen fees (\$30)
- Added language regarding international coaches obtaining background screening
- Added language regarding requirement for Juniors turning 18 to complete Safe Sport training
- Updated language regarding SafeSport refresher trainings for adults
- Added language regarding membership and background screen requirements for Junior coaches turning 18.
- Updated language in Membership On Hold policy to call clubs "active" rather than "in good standing"
- Added language regarding 2-year length of background screen with secondary screen after first year.
- Added language regarding length of time needed for processing background screen
- Inserted USAV memorandum dated 12/31/2019 regarding background checks
- Added requirement that out-of-region teams must email Webpoint roster to Junior coordinator for verification of work team certifications and SafeSport training
- Updated initial certification requirements and annual certification requirements for Referees
- Added reimbursement eligibility for successful National and Junior National evaluation candidates.

The following items in the handbook need to be addressed/updated for 2020-2021:

- References to Webpoint need to be updated to new membership management system
- Change fees for Outdoor Adult and Summer Junior to \$30
- Update USAV age definitions
- Adult Section needs to be updated to be congruous with what actually occurs
- Outdoor Section needs to be updated to be congruous with what actually occurs
